

The Jericho Road Project helps women each week through the following areas:

WEEKLY OUTREACHES

Two nights a week volunteer teams take to the streets in the project's minibus, meeting the women in the red light district. They provide a listening ear along with a hot drink and food.

Life Centre

Clients are welcome to visit the Jericho Road Base three afternoons a week where they are provided with a creative & a loving environment. Clients are able to access information, advocacy and referrals, as well as take part in creative workshops and build relationships with JRP team.

PRISON VISITING AND RESETTLEMENT

Project staff and volunteers work with clients whilst in prison, visiting them and assisting with resettlement following release.



MENTORING

The Jericho Road Project works with Aspire Drug Mentoring Project, which provides support to people who are experiencing problematic drug use.

In the last 12 months over 100 women have been helped by the project; of which 72 were seen during outreach, 40 visited the project's base and 29 were visited in prison. During outreaches 303 individual meetings with clients occurred and 226 visits to the project's base took place.

- ◆ Being a voice for those marginalised by the sex industry.

Working closely with Churches & other agencies

The project has 4 staff members and 50 volunteers from 18 different Churches. It is managed by a management team from St Andrew's Church, the Christian Centre and the Nottingham Prayer Network. The project also works in partnership with other Nottingham agencies and the police.
